

SPILLAGE PROCEDURE

“Quality education for local children”

1. Cleaning up straight away is important
2. Blood and/or body fluids, including faeces, saliva, vomit, nose and eye discharges-cleaning up promptly is very important.
3. When spillage occurs, use disposable paper towels and throw away any waste in double plastic bags which are taken directly outside.
4. To minimise the risk of cross contamination, mops should not routinely be used to clear up spills.
5. On surfaces that withstand bleach and spills of body fluids-GLOVES TO BE

WORN

Cover spill with bleach dilution

Leave for a few minutes and then clear with paper towel Clean area with a detergent dilution

Dispose of waste straight away

OR

If no bleach can be used

Remove as much spillage as possible with paper towel Clean area with a detergent dilution

Leave as dry as possible

Dispose of waste straight away.
